1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

Cllr Boasman declared a Pecuniary interest in item 4 on the agenda.

2. APOLOGIES

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

4. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

A site visit to Patrington works has been arranged for 14 Sept from 6pm until 7pm. YWA have advised dates for their events as 15 and 24 September from 3pm until 7pm. Flyers are to be hand delivered by Cllrs with these dates handwritten. Chair is to be spokesperson for Gazette purposes. Cllr Ives advised that the proposed site for the new works down Long Lane is a Little Owl habitat and these are endangered birds. Cllr Ives is to contact The Owl Trust to ask for their advice in these circumstances.

5. XMAS LIGHTS

Clerk advised that she had contacted Vicky Nielan at ERYC as she administers the Local Grant Scheme for Holderness who stated that the scheme didn't cover grants for Christmas lights. Vicky advised Clerk refers to the Community Support website for East Riding and searches on this website were without success. Cllr Ives is to ask landlord of The Plough if the proceeds of the Harvest Festival could be donated for the benefit of villagers ie for a fighting fund regarding the waste water treatment plant and Christmas lighting.

6. PLANNING

Application ref 15/02149/PLF in the name of Alan Drescher for ground mounted solar panels on North Carr Dales Road was discussed by Cllrs and a vote resulted in 1 in favour and 3 against on the grounds of proximity to the Little Owls habitat, loss of farmland to renewable energy and it would be an eyesore.  
Application ref 15/02459/PLF in the name of Mr R Clubley for erection of a dwelling on land west of Fairgarth, Northside Road was discussed by Cllrs and a vote resulted in 4 against unanimously on the grounds of it being outside the village plan, it was green field land and an application had previously been refused on the same grounds. Clerk to advise ERYC Planning of these decisions via the new electronic system.
