1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

Cllrs Boasman & Burrell declared a Pecuniary interest in item 5 on the agenda.

2. APOLOGIES

Cllr Ward was not at the meeting. Cllr Laycock has resigned.

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

4. MATTERS ARISING

None.

5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Chair advised that YWA have informed us that their plans are on hold at the moment after referring to their stakeholders and village residents but we mustn't be complacent. He stated that he had received a call from Simon Dibby (Finance YWA) and Simon said he had researched YWA plans and said there were Shoreline Management line problems but would like to keep existing site subject the it being defended. ERYC are to look at their coastal defence policy again. YWA could defend this site subject to planning permission. Precedents had been set at Easington & Mappleton and it was current Government policy not to defend and ERYC were adhering to this but permission could be granted. YWA simply hadn't looked at this option. Mayor Patrick Spicer advised that objections to planning must be within objections criteria and we have 21 days to object online. Chair stated that Parish Council should write to Rory Stewart MP, Environment Minister at DEFRA and East Yorkshire MP Sir Greg Knight to press for our coastline to be defended. A member of the public stated that if this plan could be taken forward then YWA would have no alternative in the circumstances than to develop existing cliff top site if it were to be defended. A member of the public stated that he though we should press ERYC rather than YWA to defend the coast. Mayor stated Hollym PC has all Withernsea Town Councillors backing to object to YWA's on hold proposals. He also stated that we mustn't be complacent and must keep it in front of everybody. We should wait until plans go in and then bombard them with objections within 21 days (for if on hold plans go ahead) Letters of objection should be linked to YWA's objectives. Clerk will receive planning application electronically and then forward this on to Cllrs next day. Clerk confirmed this was correct. He stated that Hollym PC should contact Graham Stewart, Rory Stewart, Greg Knight and our MEP Diane Wallis to push for coastal defence and to ask for their support. Clerk to attend. Clerk to send copy of draft minutes of this meeting to Simon Dibby at YWA (now known to be Simon Gibby) and state that they are pleased their plans are on hold at the minute and that we must work together to a mutual goal in obtaining coastal defence with a view to saving existing plant. Cllr Boasman stated that YWA want to keep their outfall pipe into the sea rather than having outfall into Winestead Drain. Mayor advised that PC should wait for YWA's next move. The drop-in meeting is still to go ahead and Joe Speck of the Working Party explained to the Mayor that they were going to present awareness information to the public. Clerk distributed flyers to cover both Hollym & Withernsea south for distribution by Cllrs and Mayor.
