

HOLLYM PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES TO MONTHLY MEETING HELD ON THE 14 MARCH 2016 IN THE VILLAGE HALL

1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

Cllr Boasman declared a Pecuniary interest in item 5 on the agenda. Cllr Jull declared a Non-Pecuniary interest in item 6 & 12 on the agenda.

2. APOLOGIES

Cllr Burrell was not at the meeting.

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

4. MATTERS ARISING

5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Cllrs attended a briefing by Yorkshire Water at the Meridian Centre regarding up to date intentions before this meeting whereby YWA informed us of an alternative site down Myers Lane (off the A1033 at Happy Landings) Cllr Jull wondered if YWA are allowed to upgrade Myers? If not, a brand new road would be locked and gated by YWA. He is also still concerned regarding the potential for odour and the timescale of any corrective action. Cllr Ward stated that any odours would be more likely to affect Hollym. Heavy lorries would not need to come through Hollym to this site which would be more favourable than the North Carr Dales Road site. A Community Compensation Fund would need to be set up by YWA with benefits to the village including a new Village Hall, new Christmas lighting and a Playground. Cllrs are to ask for the Planning Application to have a 106 agreement re penalty clauses regarding odour etc and to be referred to the appropriate committee/sub-committee.

6. FLOODING

Cllr Jull of Hollym Flood Action Group advised that cameras had been put down only half of the village culverts and that these had been partially jetted out. ERYC had cleaned out gullies down Northside Road after a report to them of flooding after heavy rain but the villages watercourses had flowed well during a wet period. Clerk to put on next Agenda to monitor.

7. FLYERS

Cllr Jull produced two types of draft flyer and Cllrs chose the more aged effect flyer. Cllrs also agreed that this flyer should be produced at the end of April in line with important dates. Clerk to put on next Agenda.

8. CLERKS POTENTIAL PENSION

As Hollym Parish Council is an employer and the Clerk it's employee then it legally has to offer Clerk a pension to which it will have to contribute. This was offered and declined.
