1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

Cllr Jull declared a Non-Pecuniary interest in item 5 on the agenda.

2. APOLOGIES

Cllr Burrell was not at the meeting.

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

4. MATTERS ARISING

5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

A recent letter has been received by residents regarding the site to the south of the village as Yorkshire Water are investigation the possibilities of this alternative site. A subsequent meeting was arranged by residents of Hollym. Yorkshire Water's erosion lines differ from those provided by ERYC for the cliff top site. Questions to Yorkshire Water still remain unanswered regarding this alternative site regarding technology to be used. Cllr Jull questioned YW ability to complete relevant investigations as to nature within their proposed timescale. The south site will be visible, the local Ward Councillor seems to be supporting this site and YW claim that village residents are happy with this site.

6. FLOODING

Cllr Jull of Hollym Flood Action Group stated that his e-mails requesting a copy of the video culvert investigations are going unanswered by ERYC. The spoil is, as yet, uncleared. There is only one sensor at South Leys Road. Recycling bins are attracting rubbish which is blowing into the dyke at South Carr Dales Road. These bins will be monitored regarding usage and possible removal?

7. FLYERS

There is not enough room on A5 paper so A4 will be used and will include bullet points for council meetings with a reference to ERYC website for full minutes. Distribution will be at the end of April and Councillors were advised of their delivery addresses.

8. CHRISTMAS LIGHTS

Mick Lenney has offered use of his piece of land opposite Smook Hills Road for fundraising activities ie Car Boot sale to assist with fundraising for the replacement Christmas lights. This was greeted with appreciation by Cllrs. Will look at when warmer weather arrives. Cllr Ward had received a flyer from Tesco's regarding supporting the local community. Hollym WI are to litter pick the village.

9. HOLLYMPICS

Harold Jobling explained that this sub-committee held it's third meeting the previous night and the sports day was to be held in June. The Parish Council's Public Liability Insurance provided by Zurich was being asked

to cover these events and he had answered their queries regarding activities and a possible increase in premium which Hollympics could cover subject to amount. Accordingly, activities have been refined. Small local businesses are to be approached for sponsorship at £20 and individuals can also sponsor for £10. There is to be a Treasure Hunt on foot around the village on 1 May to help with fundraising.
