Letter from Emma Burrell advising of her resignation. Letter from ERYC advising to Co-opt. Letter re 'Don't swallow up your NHS campaign.

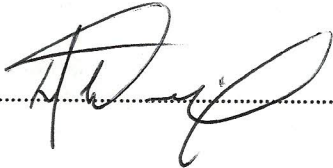
12. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

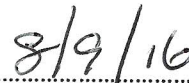
