3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

4. MATTERS ARISING

Clerk advised that she had obtained 'Dog Fouling' notices for the village and stencil was to be applied for once these had been put up. She had not received a reply from the Dog Warden regarding straying dog and Parish was informed that a member of the public had phoned ERYC at the time this dog was straying and were told that unless this dog was detained by the public then the Dog Warden would not come out. The Hollympics final accounts were available showing a surplus of £112.15 and this was to be held in the Parish Council's account ring-fenced until a further event was to be held. Beneficiaries of this event were McMillan Cancer Care £141 donation, Withernsea Rugby Club £450 donation and Hollym & Holmpton Churches £350 donation.

5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Clerk is to enquire of Andy McLachlan whether the 400/500 meter cliff defence outside Newsham Gardens is going ahead. Then to arrange a meeting with YWA reps, Andy McLachlan, Mayor and Deputy Mayor of Withernsea, Cllr Dave Tucker and Gavin Scott to re-inforce the common sense approach which is to defend existing site.

Application in the name of Mr J Smith for outline planning permission for the erection of a bungalow on land east of Orchard Garth, North Leys Road ref no. 16/02547/OUT was voted unanimously against approving on the grounds of concerns over flooding, sewerage and size of bungalow. Also Cllrs felt it was outside the village structure plan.
