5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Clerk still muted the possibility of a meeting between all interested parties with the result that ERYC said that they not in a position to be able to contribute usefully, YWA did reply but stated that this meeting would not result in the cliff top site being taken forward in view of the lack of time.
