1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

2. APOLOGIES

Cllr Dearing was not at the meeting.

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

4. MATTERS ARISING

Clerk reported that she had costed the Arnold Baker paperback at £62.92 from Amazon, reported Pearcey Lane verge obstructions to Highways and advised villager accordingly. She had reported dead trees in Manor Lane to ERYC and obtained confirmation that they would be removed within 3 months. Also that repairs are required to the path down Northside Road along with white bollards needed in Church Lane. Cllr Jull reported that he had repaired the bus shelter along with the help of Cllr Sissons. Cllrs Boasman & Jull are to remove the planters from Pearcey Lane and Cllr Ward is to refresh them and they are to be relocated to the main road outside Pearcey Lane to replace the rotten wooden ones.

South Holderness Ward Cllr Dave Tucker advised that he started this role wef August 2016 and it was to be a bridge between Parish Councils and County Hall. Updates with his news will be via a Newsletter to 16,000 homes. He is also to attend our meetings to advise on progress within his role and support Parish with any concerns. He urged Parish to write to ERY Clinical Commissioning Group with their concerns regarding the proposed closure of Withernsea MIU and the removal of beds. Clerk to attend. The proposal to remove ambulances from Withernsea during the hours of midnight to 6am has been abandoned due to the discovery of a previous signing of a legally binding contract. The intention to remove Payphones is being challenged due to patchy mobile reception in this area. Policing is an area for concern as intended cover is not being maintained and we are left without cover. FLAG is a coastal area funding scheme with £800k available this year and DONG Energy have made £500k available for the next 20 years with a max of £50k per project. He advised that SHAPE is on-line again. A meeting was arranged for Cllr Tucker to meet Chair Fred Dearing on 21 December to take his concerns forward regarding Coastal Erosion.

5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

No change. Clerk enquired to Highways the status of Myers Lane and reported that it is a public highway of Green Lane status.

6. PLANNING

Application in the name of Mr & Mrs D Smith for change of use and a garage at Manor Farm, North Leys Road has been granted by ERYC. Application for Colleys & Kenwood Camp has been withdrawn.
