#### 1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

Cllr Jull declared a Non-Pecuniary Interest in item 7 on the Agenda.

#### 2. APOLOGIES

Cllrs Sissons, Lindgren & Ives were not at the meeting.

#### 3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

#### 4. MATTERS ARISING

Clerk reported that she written a thank you letter to the Church Wardens of Hollym Church re their electricity, contacted ERNLLCA re purchasing Arnold Baker book. ERNLLCA recommended Local Councils Explained but Cllrs voted 3 to 1 not to purchase any book) Clerk contacted Highways re speed survey (which is to be opposite Dunstan on the A1033) Cllr Jull stated that he had attended the 1<sup>st</sup> Aid training in Holmpton and obtained information re a Defibrillator. He also stated that the 2% increase in Hollym's Precept had been shown as a reduction and investigated way forward for next year. Cllrs discussed planters down Pearcey Lane and decided that they should stay after being looked after beautifully for the last 20 yrs approx.

#### 5. INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD

Cllrs had invited Ralph Ward & John Maston of the newly formed South Holderness Drainage Board to brief them on the amalgamation of the 6 existing internal drainage boards in Holderness to just one on the instructions of Defra. The new board is made up of 12 members from the old boards plus 7 ERYC Councillors. 130 miles of drain is maintained with Sunk Island having its own Crown Estates authority with their own facilities. Current income is £200k raised by a rate on agricultural land, a levy from ERYC and funding from the Environmental Agency. The changing costs will be from £15 per acre max to £1 per acre for land not currently rated per annum. The new drainage board will have the authority to take enforcement action and undertake work and bill the owner of the land. Relevant maps were retained by Cllrs who thanked Messrs Ward & Maston for their time and information.

#### 6. S. HOLDERNESS WARD COUNCILLOR BRIEFING

Cllr Dave Tucker was unable to attend the meeting.

#### 7. FLOODING

Clerk reported that she had written to all Riparian Owners as instructed by Cllrs at their last meeting and feedback was beginning.
