1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record after inclusion of Cllr Ward in item 14 on the agenda

4. CLLR TUCKER BRIEFING

Cllr Tucker was unable to attend the meeting.

5. MATTERS ARISING

Cllrs Jull & Sissons have dealt with Pearcey Lane hedge matters and Cllr Jull has resolved grass dumping issues at the recycling bin. Cllr Ward has resolved grass dumping issues at the Village Hall. There is to be a Car Boot on 6 August and this is to be advertised in the next Flyer. Planters are to be re-arranged.

6. ESTUARY TV LETTER

Clerk is to contact this media channel to investigate if there would be any interest from them in highlighting the villages Yorkshire Water Sewage Plant issues.

7. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Letters have been received by residents with update but no more firm information was forthcoming.

8. HOLLYM EMERGENCY PLAN.

Clerk completed as far as possible and Cllr Ward is to ask the Church if they would be agreeable to us using the Church as a contingency meeting place in case of need.

9. FLOODING

Cllr. Jull advised that the culvert at Mill Lane has been cleared of bricks and stated that ERYC would prefer to rebuild this culvert but funds were not available. The culvert at Manor Lane is ok. Clerk is to write to remaining riparian owner who has not cleaned their dyke yet with a gentle reminder. Cllr Jull also advised that the whole system had been surveyed for the 6th time regarding capacity and clerk is to contact Steve Clayton to ask for these results. Clerk is also to mention to him that surveyors accessed private land without permission and ask him to finish jetting the dyke down the bridle path.

10. TRAINING

Cllr Jull is to attend the 'Good Councillor' course run by ERNLLCA and clerk to attend promptly to ensure half priced course is obtained.

11. DEFIBRILLATOR

A letter has been received from the Village Hall Committee agreeing to the siting of one of the Defibrillators at the Village Hall. Agreement from The Plough is still to come and then a firm quote can be obtained and the Awards for All grant application can be completed. There is a 6-8 week turnaround for this grant.



