1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

Cllr Jull declared a Non-Pecuniary Interest in item 11 on the Agenda.

2. APOLOGIES

Cllrs Boasman & Ives were not at the meeting.

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record after the addition of 'Cllrs voted on the posts 4 to 1 in favour of the motion' at item 9.

4. MATTERS ARISING

Cllr Jull stated that the planters still hadn't been moved. Cllrs Jull & Sissons to take forward. Cllr Dearing stated that the Car Boot Sale had raised £213.33 for the Xmas Lights Appeal. Next Car Boot to be held on 1 Oct. Clerk to arrange advertising of and Cllr Sissons to complete Risk Assessment. Cllr Dearing confirmed Estuary TV item had been shown regarding coastal defending and YWA Sewage Plant.

5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

A Licence to protect outfall pipe had been applied for by YWA again. Parish stance is to protect all the coast and Clerk is to invite Ward Cllrs Healing, Tucker & Cracknell to our next meeting to push for this outcome. A rep from Holmpton PC is also to be invited.

6. PLANNING

Outline planning application for 2 dwellings plus garages with access ref 17/02606/OUT on land west of Valley Farm, Smook Hills Lane was discussed by Cllrs and refused on the grounds of it being outside the village plan, on green belt land and it not being infill. Cllrs believed that under sustainable development Hollym already had its quota for this year. Cllrs voted 4 against with 1 abstention. Clerk to attend.

7. VILLAGE HALL

Clerk reported that there had been no response to Parish's letter to Mr Drescher. Cllr Sissons is to draft a letter to all committee members and Trustees asking them to arrange a meeting of their committee.

8. GRAVEL PIT AREA

Clerk reported that she had received no response from Parish's letter to Messrs Stephenson's farmers. Cllrs mentioned that her wording could have been taken that there was a fly tipping problem associated with the remaining recycling bin so maybe this was why there was no reply. Cllr Dearing to take forward. There are no vehicles parked on this area now.
