### 2. APOLOGIES

### 3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.1.

### 4. MATTERS ARISING

Clerk advised that she had e-mailed Steve Charlton @ ERYC to request sight of results of previous jetting and completion of same. Clerk also advised that she has written to Riparian Owners regarding cleaning of dykes. Cllr Jull requested Clerk to contact Dog Warden asking for his visual presence in the village to help deter dog fouling and Cllr Dearing asked Clerk to obtain more stickers. Car Boot was cancelled at 9am on the morning of the sale due to minimal public interest.

### 5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Cllr Dearing advised that all efforts to obtain sea defence in front of the existing sewage works so that they could stay in situ had failed. Cllrs Healing and Cracknell advised that funding for 400m of defence at the south end of the prom was to be applied for by ERYC. This would help protect Newsham Gardens only. They also advised that they had requested ERYC engineers Mike Ball & Neil McLachlan to attend this meeting with them but had been unsuccessful in their request. A meeting with all interested parties plus the engineers is still being pursued. They advised that there would be a public consultation with all interested parties and YWA before any planning went in. The definite site is still unknown but the outfall pipe is to be moved and in the short-term a licence to protect the existing outfall pipe is to be applied for. The material for this protection will be craned onto the beach. Everybody present agreed that total defence of the cliffs wanted to be past Holmpton. Chair thanked Cllrs Healing & Cracknell, all Holmpton Parish Cllrs and members of the public for attending.

### 6. VILLAGE HALL

Cllr Sissons is to draft a letter to Mr Drescher, committee members and Trustees asking them to arrange a meeting of their committee. Clerk to circulate draft copy of letter to all Cllrs for pre-approval and delivery.
