John Bond attended meeting and was welcomed by Chair. He stated that work had been completed replacing missing rock nets in liaison with Jeremy Pickles. He stated that spares were to be kept on site quickening the process in future. The three elements of the project, namely the rising main, the long sea outfall and the actual treatment works were now all to be completed at the same time due to the requirement by the MMO of a full EIA (after appeal). This timescale was 2022 completion. Planning is now planned for Autumn. Protection of the existing outfall pipe was continuing along with LIDAR surveys. Weekly photographs taken by ERYC of the site are to be produced to Jeremy Pickles, Lyn Healing, Dave Tucker and John Bond. Cllr Dearing thanked John Bond for attending the meeting.
