1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Cllr Jull stated that we had still not received LIDAR info from John Bond & photographic evidence of coastal erosion from ERYC. Chair to contact Cllr Tucker to request. Cllr Boasman expressed concern regarding the two year timescale for the effectiveness of the rock sacks to the outfall pipe. Cllr Jull suggested a public meeting be arranged regarding the Community Gift requirements although a Sewage Works for Withernsea has been in Hollym for the past 47 years with no compensation. Local publicity to be arranged. Agreement to Community Funding by YWA to be obtained in writing.

6. BUS SHELTER SEATS

First attempt at installing seats failed due to equipment breakdown. Cllr Boasman to arrange appropriate equipment for Cllrs Jull & Sissons to install.

Questionnaire presented to Cllrs by Cllr Sissons had not been agreed by Village Hall Committee so Cllrs felt they could not yet comment.
