### 1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

### 2. APOLOGIES

Cllr Sissons has resigned.

### 3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The minutes (which had previously been circulated) were approved and signed as a true record.

### 4. MATTERS ARISING

As Cllr Sissons has resigned Cllr Jull is to take forward the loose dog issue with the Dog Warden. Cllr Jull is also to post signs around the village regarding dog fouling to be backed up by posters designed by children and Cllr Lindgren. Cllr Tucker is to organise a village walk-around with Environmental Services with a view to increasing the amount of bins able to take dog waste.

### 5. YORKSHIRE WATER PROPOSALS

Emma Jose and Michael R Smith updated Cllrs regarding Planning & LSO. Michael stated that letters have been sent out to all villagers on 22 June and Planning was submitted on 26 June. They expect a decision by 4 Oct 2018. The next update to Cllrs will be Sept/Oct. Emma stated that there has been no requirement to maintain the LSO due to improved weather/sea conditions. They were still monitoring the beach levels and cliff erosion monthly. LIDAR info was supplied in hardcopy format (Emma to supply electronically to Clerk). YW are still in touch with the Coastal Team (on a monthly basis) of which Jeremy Pickles is concerned with the build-up of sand on the northern side of the LSO. These reports are also supplied to MMO. New LSO construction permission is expected in the next 6 months. ERYC do not want an EIA but MMO require one! An external Marine Consultant is employed by YW whom is recognised by ERYC. Clerk to invite Emma to Oct meeting. Chair thanked Emma and Michael for attending the meeting.

### 6. BRIEFING BY CLLR TUCKER

ERYC expect to hear result of their application for funding to defend south of Withernsea imminently. He stated that the Out of Hours cover for this area is confusing and shambolic. A Director from the Clinical Commissioning Group is to be invited to Sept meeting to explain. Clerk to allow 30 minutes on Sept Agenda.
