3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

5. PLANNING

App. No 19/00574/OUT ino Miss L Smith for outline planning for the erection of a 2/3bed bungalow on land west of Strathmore, North Leys Rd was approved subject to size and satisfactory offroad parking. App No 19/00563/STPLF for rock armour to south of Withernsea was approved with concerns voiced for the effect on the road and cliffs south of the rock armouring.

6. DEVELOPMENT IN COASTAL ZONE

Cllr Jull stated that concerns had been raised to him regarding the new compound appearing on land north of the existing sewage plant . Did it need formal planning consent? Chair stated that this may become clearer at the end of the meeting when Cllrs were to receive a presentation regarding the new owners intentions for this land.

7. FLAIL MOWING/CUTTING HEDGES

Cllr Jull stated that concerns had been raised to him regarding the debris left on the roads and paths after recent flailing of hedges on the main road and on Northside Road. The contractor concerned ran his flail without baffles resulting in an improved result but with increased spread of the debris. Cllr Boasman stated that hedges had to be flailed before the end of February so this hazard should now cease. An item regarding this is to be inserted in the next Newsletter.

Cllrs decided to support HART to the extent of £50. Chair stated that donations had been forthcoming from TESCOS for the Table Top Sale. Cllr Ward stated that the new Xmas lights had been taken down and that the

existing gardener had stepped down and that a new gardener was required. Cllrs will try to appoint a new gardener.

Mr Mokhtar Kourgli of J K N Polymers Ltd, Sutton Fields Industrial Est. Hull attended the meeting by invitation to address Cllrs regarding Item 6 on the Agenda. He has acquired 16 acres of cliff top land north of the sewage plant to Intack and then the plot at the other side of Intack to the airstrip. He stated that he is proactively working to stem the effects of coastal erosion by applying to the authorities to sheet pile his land and apply for a 40m wind turbine to pump any flood water back onto the beach. He produced information regarding his method style based on long term successful techniques used in Holland and is in touch with the relevant authorities/ coastal engineers and will apply for any permissions required. He is receiving support for his plans so far. Chair thanked Mr Kourgli for his attendance at the meeting and for his information .
