1. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

2. APOLOGIES

Cllrs Ives & Dearing were unable to attend the meeting.

3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The minutes (which had previously been circulated) were approved and signed as a true record.

4. MATTERS ARISING

Cllr Jull stated that issues arising from Defib training had been mentioned in the Newsletter and that the Fire Service was now taking forward the training along with Patrington Parish Council. Cllr Purse was waiting to hear from them. Clerk advised Cllrs that the remaining re-cycling bin had been removed as requested.

5. CO-OPT ANOTHER COUNCILLOR

Richard Oliver attended the meeting expressing his interest in becoming a Parish Councillor. He introduced himself and gave a brief presentation. Cllrs voted unanimously in favour of Co-opting Richard as a Parish Councillor. Cllr Oliver was welcomed.

6. SPEEDING AT CROSSROADS

After receiving complaints as to the speed of motorists on the main road at the crossroads, making crossing the road and pulling out of Northside Road hazardous, Cllrs discussed ways to make traffic reduce their speed. Enquiries have already revealed that a flashing sign would cost £3,500 approx and would have to be purchased by the Parish and authorised by ERYC. Painted speed limit signs in the road and painted bars in the road were also discussed. Clerk is to enquire of Highways regarding costs and any grants available. Also to enquire of Police as to frequency of monitoring speed by cameras and prosecutions by road safety partnerships.
