3. MINUTES TO THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS
The minutes (which had previously been circulated) were approved and signed as a true record.
4. MATTERS ARISING
Cllr Jull stated that the further information requested from ERYC by the Clerk regarding the addresses of overgrown hedges had not been forthcoming .
5. PLANNING
App ref 19/02601/PLF ino Martin Hoey for erection of 2 storey extension & balcony to rear and single storey extension to rear and side of Hill Farm, Church Lane was granted by ERYC along with App ref 19/00563/STPLF ino ETYC for Rock armouring to the south of Withernsea. App ref 19/03333/PLF ino Mr J Speck was discussed and plans approved unanimously (with Cllr Lindgren not voting) Cllr Jull mentioned that the velux windows would make installation of Solar PV panels impossible.
6. PINFOLD OWNERSHIP & MAINTENANCE
Chair stated that proof of ownership by the village is on the Enclosures Act documents as advised by Hazel Armstrong at the last meeting. Chair stated that self registration is possible and he is to print forms from the Internet to take forward. Cllr Jull has advised Jacqui Laycock accordingly. Andrew Laycock is to maintain the Pinfold wef 1.10.2019 at a cost of £100 pa paid quarterly. Clerk to write to Andrew to confirm.

Cllr Healing advised that rock armour proposals for Withernsea had been passed by ERYC and the next stage of funding was looking positive. Operation Galleo apprehended several men with dogs in Holmpton suspected of Hare Coursing. She advised villagers to phone 101 if they had any suspicions of this activity and this advice is to be mentioned in the next Newsletter. The saga with the Withernsea 8-8 Centre is still ongoing and Cllr Healing & Cllr Tucker are to have a meeting with John Skidmore (ERYC) next week and CCG in November. Arrangements at present are totally unsatisfactory.
