REPORT TO HOLLYM PARISH COUNCIL – ADDITIONAL BINS

Meeting: 10 July 2020 09:00

Present: Dave Cook – ERYC
Councillor Bernard Jull

Place: Parish of Hollym

The above named met at Hollym Village Hall following a request by Hollym Parish Council for additional bins in the village due to an excess of dog fouling in certain areas of the parish. Councillor Bernard Jull and Councillor Fred Dearing having received complaints from residents.

Councillor Bernard Jull asked Dave Cook why the bins are so expensive and showed examples of alternative cheaper bins, also why we cannot have smaller bins? In addition, he also raised a query regarding the cost of installation.

Dave Cook advised that ERYC only supply these bins, the reason for the type is that it is easier and more cost effective to replace parts on these bins. In addition, they have found that this type of bins has a longer life span. They do not do smaller bins. Parish Councils who have a smaller bin have supplied their own and arrange for disposal of the waste themselves. ERYC have undertaken a Risk Assessment and on Health & Safety grounds they will only use and empty the bins being offered to us. Regarding installation cost, he advised that this went out to tender every 3 years and the cost has remained around the same again this time round, he cannot assist with this element and we cannot install ourselves.

A walkabout around the village was undertaken and Councillor Bernard Jull advised that the main area of concern was Manor Road, South Leys Road, South Carr Dales Road and Smook Hills Road (Pearcey Lane).

Dave Cook of ERYC confirmed that all of the following locations are viable for an additional bin:

Junction of Manor Lane/South Leys Road
Near Junction of Vicar Lane / South Carr Dales Road
Top of Smook Hills Road (Pearcey Lane)

However, we can only have 2 bins.

When the Parish Council decide upon the location and bins are installed, they initially will be emptied weekly and this may be varied dependent upon use.

The cost per bin is:

Bin	£377.00 plus VAT
Installation	<u>£105.00</u> plus VAT
	£482.00
VAT	<u>£ 96.40</u>
Total	<u>£578.40</u>

The meeting concluded at 10:00 and we thanked Dave Cook for his time.
