I, Nigel Pearson, as the Police Area Returning Officer appointed at the Election for the Police and Crime Commissioner for the Humberside Police Area on 5 May 2016, hereby certify that:

The total number of valid first preference votes cast for each of the candidates is as follows:

HUNTER, Keith	Labour and Co-operative Party	62,010
WHITEHEAD, Michael Stephen	UK Independence Party (UKIP)	27,434

The total number of ballot papers verified is156,502

The turnout in this police area at this election is22.84%

The total number of rejected ballot papers is4,692

As no candidate received more than 50% of the valid first preference votes every Local Returning Officer will now count the second preference votes for the candidates who are not eliminated from the contest.
