EXAMPLE:

New cattery will pay £250 and this will cover the cost of a 1 year licence. If during the inspection it is identified that they meet the higher standard and are able to get a 2 year licence additional £125 will be required before the licence is granted.

A new cattery and kennels would pay £250 application fee +£100 for the additional activity and this will cover the cost of 1 year licence. If during the inspection it is identified that they meet the higher standard and are able to get a 2 year licence additional £125 +£60 for the additional activity will be required before the licence is granted.
